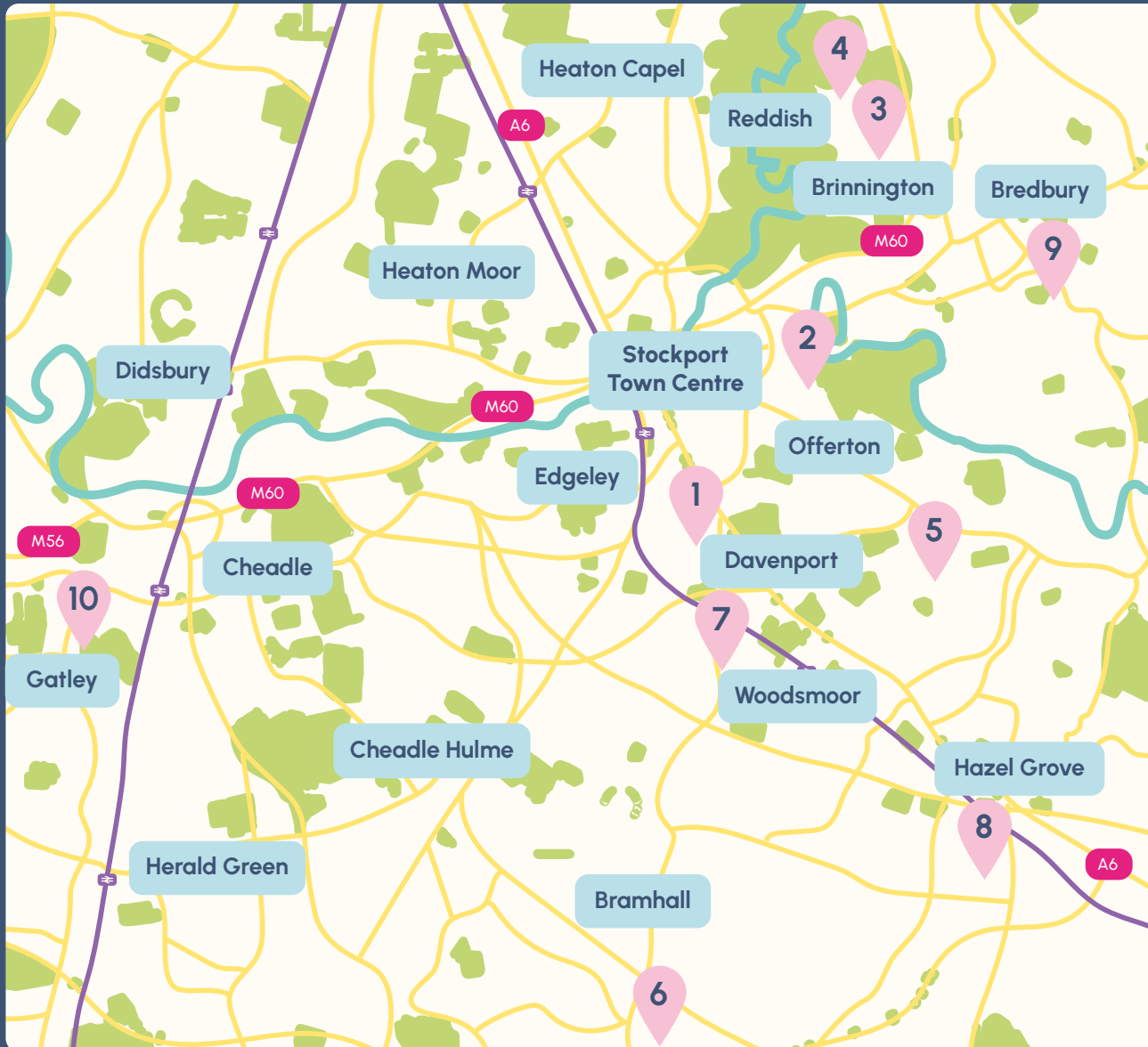

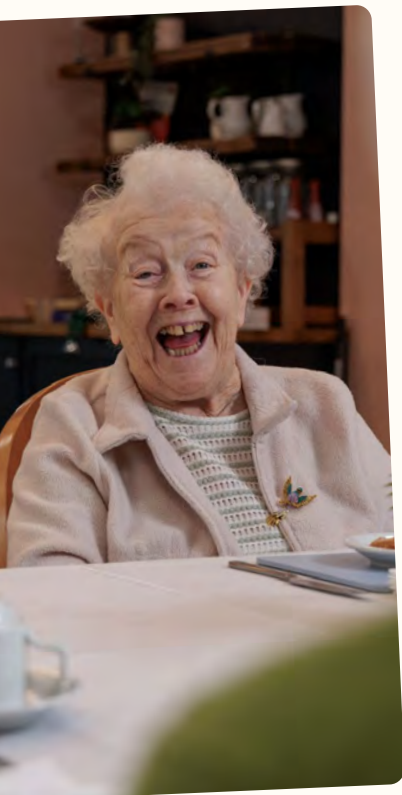


7 Reinbek Davenport

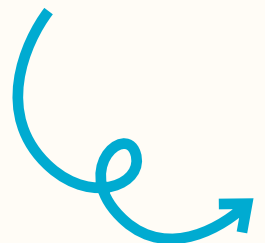
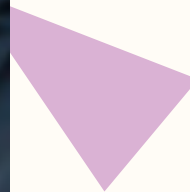

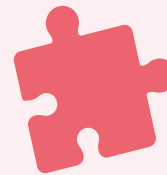
We believe everyone should feel encouraged, empowered, and supported to enjoy life to the fullest — **whatever their health or abilities.**
